This Interlocutory Application is filed under the caption ‘for being mentioned’ seeking modification of the order by incorporating the words in para 6 of the order after the words “to the posts of Junior Lecturers under 10% quota” by adding “and the next higher posts in the non-teaching category, as per their eligibility”, in the order passed by this Court in W.P. No.2376 of 2026, dated 12.03.2026, which reads as follows: <i>“6. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court is inclined to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the respondents, particularly the 3rd respondent, to consider the case of the petitioners for inclusion in the panel for appointment to the post of Junior Lecturer under the 10% quota, in accordance with law, and pass appropriate orders within a period of two (02) months from the date of receipt of the copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.”</i>	

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		Taking into consideration of the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and for the reasons stated therein, this Court deems it appropriate to substitute the order passed in the writ petition in the following terms: <i>“6. considering the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court is inclined to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the respondents, particularly the 3rd respondent, to consider the case of the petitioners for inclusion in the panel for appointment and the next higher posts in the non-teaching category, as per their eligibility, in accordance with law, and pass appropriate orders within a period of two (02) months from the date of receipt of the copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.”</i> Accordingly, this Interlocutory Application No. 1 of 2026 is ordered. Registry is directed to incorporate the necessary changes before issuing a fresh copy of the orders. DR, J RMD
