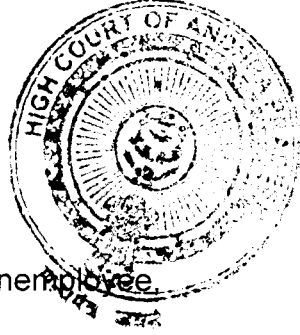

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate Sri S Gopal Rao presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, by declaring the proceedings of the 3rd respondent bearing Rc.No.1985/A2/2018, dt. 4-12-2020, rejecting the claim of the petitioners for appointment as Secondary Grade Teachers and posting orders to that effect, as illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and unconstitutional being violative of Articles 14 and 16 of Constitution of India and consequently direct the 3rd respondent to consider the cases of the petitioners for appointment and posting as Secondary Grade Teachers by treating them as eligible for such appointment and posting since they passed the required qualification i.e. D.Ed. examination, as per proviso to Rule 6 of A.P. Direct Recruitment for the posts of Teachers (Scheme of selection) Rules, 2008, issued in G.O.Ms.No.28, Education (Services-VI) Department, dt.29-1-2009 and issue posting orders to that effect, by conferring all consequential benefits. ✓

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri S. Gopal Rao, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted. ✓
