Aditya Chowdary, presented this Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quashing of the case in C.C.No. 3220 of 2022 in Cr.No. 197 of 2022 on the file of the Court of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class-cum-Junior Civil Judge at Movva for the offences under Sections 498-A of I.P.C. 3 & 4 of DPA.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and the Memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri K.V. Aditya Chowdary, Advocate for the Petitioners and of the Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

The Court made the following ORDER :-

“Learned Public Prosecutor has taken notice on the 1st respondent and seeks time to obtain instructions.

Issue notice to the 2nd respondent.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to the 2nd respondent by RPAD and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Post on 22.03.2023.

The petitioners are accused in C.C.No.3220 of 2022 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate of First-Class-cum-Junior Civil Judge, Movva, for the offence under Section 498- A. 34 of Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners contend that the allegations made against them in the charge sheet are general and omnibus allegations without any details as to specifics and as such, no case can be made against them.

A perusal of the charge sheet does show that there are no specific allegations against the petitioners Nos.2 & 3 except general and 2 omnibus allegations of harassment.

In the circumstances, the presence of the petitioners Nos. 2 & 3 shall be dispensed with, till further orders in C.C.No.3220 of 2022 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate of First-Class-cum Junior Civil Judge, Movva, except when their presence is required for examination.”

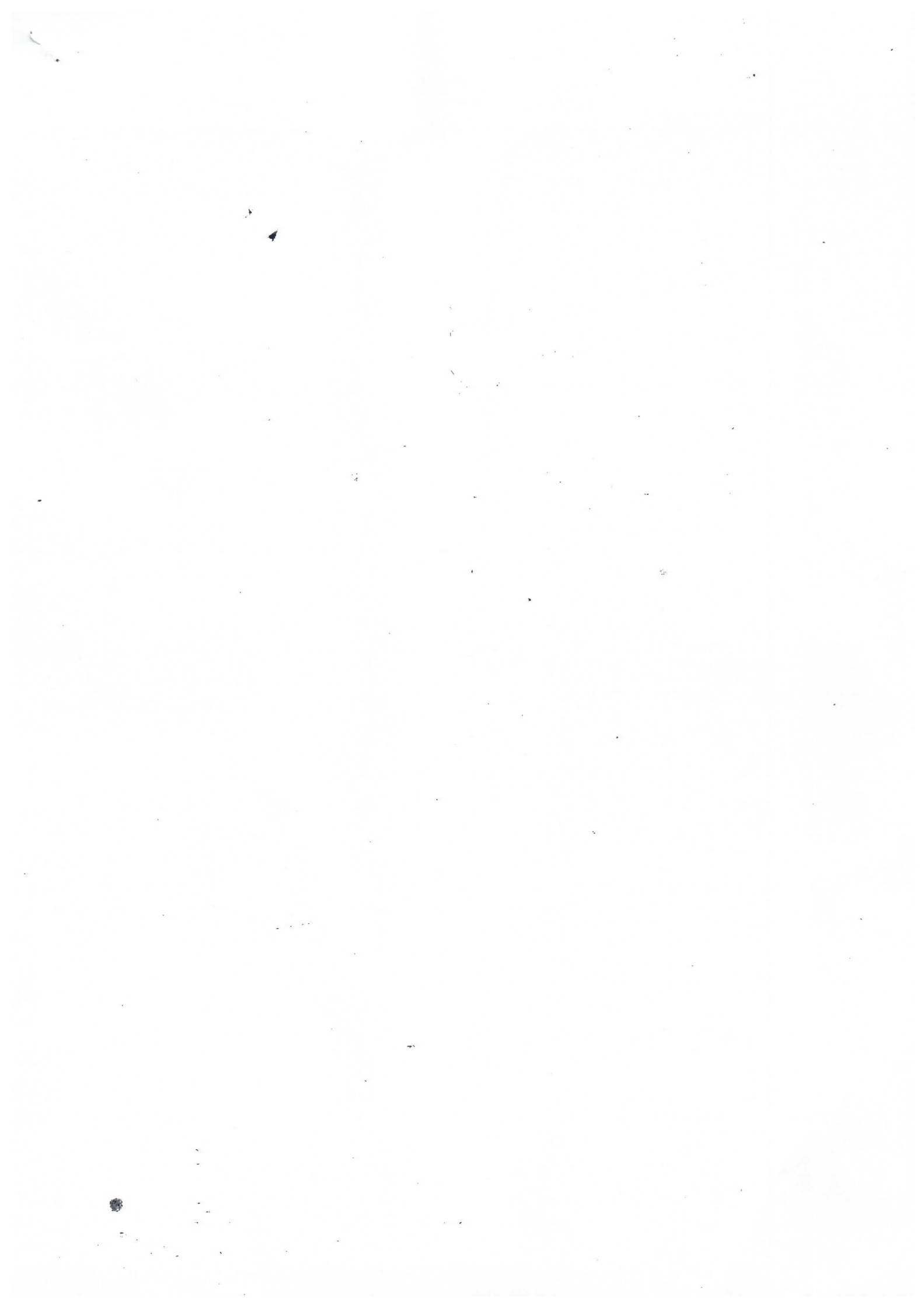
