Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased topleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of a writ of Mandamus declaring action of the respondents in not paying salary to the petitioner from the date of reinstatement i.e., from 06-09-2025 to till date, as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, violative of principle of natural justice and violative of Article 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 4th respondent to release the salary to the petitioner from 06-09-2025 to 10-10-2025 and direct the 5th respondent to release the salary from 13-10-2025 to till date and pass

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Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased pleased to direct the 5th respondent to forthwith release and pay the monthly salary to the petitioner on a regular basis for the services being rendered by him from from 13-10- 2025 to till date, pending disposal of the main Writ Petition, and pass

The Court made the following:

The Court made the following ORDER:

1. The writ petition is filed aggrieved by the action of the respondents in not paying salary to the petitioner from the date of reinstatement i.e., from 06-09-2025 to till date, which is illegal and arbitrary.
2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for the respondent Nos.1 to 5 and the learned Standing counsel for the respondent No.6
3. On an earlier occasion, this Court, vide order dated 18.03.2026, recorded the instructions issued by the District Collector dated 06.02.2026 stating that a communication had been addressed to the Managing Director, APCOS, requesting rectification of the technical error and enabling the services for approval with digital signature for the specific employee bearing APCOS ID No.107874151. Based on the said instructions, the learned Standing Counsel submitted that the 6th respondent had rectified the technical error and, accordingly, the District Collector and Magistrate forwarded the bills to the Treasury Department. Thereafter, supplementary indents were generated for the period from September 2025 to March 2026 along with the regular bill for April 2026, and the said bills were subsequently forwarded to the Treasuries for processing through CFMS.

4. Considering the same, and in view of the written instructions placed on record, this Court is of the considered view that the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent authorities to release the amounts due to the petitioner within a period of two (02) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

Consequently, Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in the writ petition shall stand closed.
