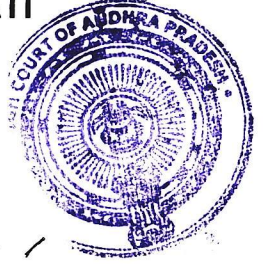

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on the respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The presence of the Petitioner/Accused No.7 is dispensed with in C.C.No.428 of 2019 on the file of the learned Judicial First Class Magistrate, Atmakur, Nandyal District, except when his presence is specifically required by the learned Trial Court.
