Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondents in not releasing amounts of Rs. 8,99,435/- in pursuant to the execution of works by the petitioner i.e., 1. Providing CC Road Harijanawada in Paravolu Village, Venkatagiri Mandal, Tirupati District under the grant of Chief Minister Development fund (CMDf) in the limits of Paravolu Village 2.

Providing CC Road from Poleramma Temple to MPP School in Paravolu Village, Venkatagiri Mandal, Tirupati District under the grant of Chief Minister Development fund (CMDf) in the limits of Paravolu Village during the year 2022-2023 as illegal, irregular, irrational, violative of provisions of Andhra Pradesh Panchayat Raj Act, 1994 and rules framed thereunder and offends Articles 14 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to release the amount of Rs. 8,99,435/- mentioned in the Measurement Books to the petitioner for the said works executed by the petitioner and to pass

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Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to release the amount of Rs. 8,99,435/- mentioned in the Measurement Books to the petitioner in respect of the execution of work 1. Providing CC Road Harijanawada in Paravolu Village, Venkatagiri Mandal, Tirupati District under the grant of Chief Minister Development fund (CMDf) in the limits of Paravolu Village 2. Providing CC Road from Poleramma Temple to MPP School in Paravolu Village, Venkatagiri Mandal, Tirupati District under the grant of Chief Minister Development fund (CMDf) in the limits of Paravolu Village during the year 2022-2023 forthwith, pending disposal of the main writ petition and pass
