

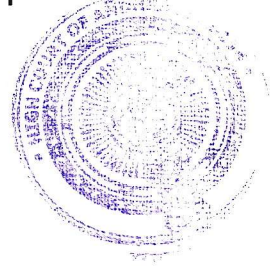

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ or direction declaring the inaction of the official respondents having found that violation of the conditions in G.O.Ms.No.7, dated 16-03-2013 and as per Rule 8(2) Section (XIII), Section 14 of A.P.S.A.D Act, 2020 and not taking any action on the unofficial Respondent No. 12, ignoring order passed in WP.No.20892 of exercise of 2024 dated 23-09-2024 as illegal, arbitrary, colorable powers of the Respondents, violation of Rule of law and consequentially direct the official Respondents to take action basing on the 8th Respondent Proceeding No.232/C-1/2024, dated 24-12-2024.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct Respondent No 8 to take immediate steps as

ORDER

Pursuant to the orders passed by this court on 18.02.2026, the District Fisheries Officer appeared virtually before this Court and stated that the respondent no.12 is presently cultivating the prawn culture contrary to the license and appropriate steps will be initiated against the said Respondent forthwith.

The District Fisheries Officer shall appear before this court virtually by the next date of adjournment and explain the steps taken by him to the Court.
