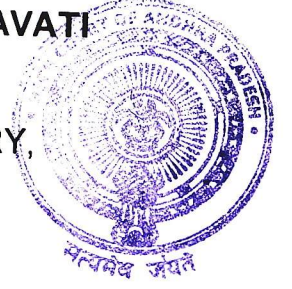

may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ or order or direction more
particularly a writ in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring the
