are hereby directed to arrest the said respondent No.3 viz; Vasu Reddy, The Executive Engineer, Rurals, APSPDCL, Tirupati, wherever he is found and produce him bodily under safe custody and conduct before this Court on 13.02.2026 at 10:30 A.M., to which date the case stands posted.

You are further directed that if the said respondent furnishes personal bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum with an undertaking affidavit that he will appear before this Court on 13.02.2026, he may be released on bail subject to the condition that he shall attend this Court on 13.02.2026 and shall continue to attend this Court until otherwise directed.

You are also further directed to return this warrant as early as possible preferably on or before 13.02.2026 to this Court with a detailed report stating the manner in which it has been executed.

Herein fail not.

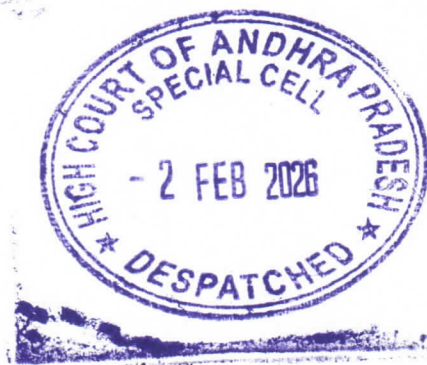
