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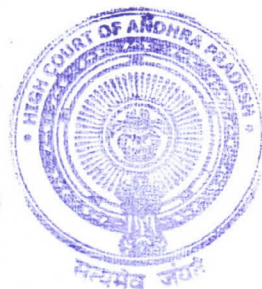

support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings in Crime No. 19 of 2025 on the file of Renigunta Urban Police Station, Tirupati District including arrest, in so far as the petitioner/Accused No.1 is concerned, Pending disposal of CRLP 1249 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI PRATHIWADA VARUN KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioner, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent No.1 and the Court made the following

ORDER

“The petitioner is working as a Deputy Tahsildar. The 2nd respondent alleges that the petitioner issued a bogus patta. However, the authority to grant a patta vests with the Mandal Revenue Officer (MRO).

The alleged offence is stated to have taken place on 11.07.2022. The 2nd respondent lodged a report with the police only on 23.01.2025, i.e., after a delay of more than three years.

A prima facie case is made out for granting a relief under Section 482 of ‘the Cr.P.C.,’/Section 528 of ‘the BNSS.,’ in Crime No. 19 of 2025 on the file of Renigunta Urban Police Station, Tirupati District. However, the investigation shall remain stayed until the next date of hearing, including any coercive steps such as the arrest of the petitioner.
