Having regard to the facts, submissions and the issues raised for consideration in the grounds of appeal, which require a detailed examination, there shall be interim stay of execution of the Order and decree, dated 26.09.2022, passed in M.V.O.P.No.14 of 2016 on the file of the Chair person, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal-cum - X- Addl.District Judge, Gurazala, subject to the condition that the appellant/Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Co. Ltd., Yerwada, Pune shall deposit 50% of the entire decretal amount with proportionate interest and costs within a period of eight (8) weeks from today.

On such deposit, respondent Nos.1 and 2/claimants are permitted to withdraw the compensation in terms of the decree with proportionate interest and costs by following the procedure established by law, however, without prejudice to the rights and contentions of both the parties in the appeal.
