Judicial First Class Magistrate, Vizianagaram filed Under Section 341, 506 of I P C.

Petition Under Section 528 of B.N.S.S/Old Under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner /accused in C C No. 1834 of 2023 on the file of Addl. Judicial First Class Magistrate, Vizianagaram filed Under section

341, 506 of I P C. and Pending disposal of CRLP 2040 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI Y SUBBA RAO Advocate for the Petitioner, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR Advocate for the Respondent Nos.1 & 2 and the Court made the following.

ORDER

“Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner, learned Counsel for Respondent No.2 and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Respondent No.2 has lodged a complaint on 24.07.2023 to the police against the Petitioner who is a practicing advocate in Vizianagaram that he had indulged in commission of an offence punishable under Sections 341 & 506 read with 34 of 'the I.P.C.'

Sri Y.Subba Rao, learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that he filed a Writ Petition vide W.P.No.32245/2023 wherein in an affidavit at paragraph No.5 he submitted that Respondent No.2 has been interfering in life and liberty of the Petitioner by conducting meetings and prayers and abusing Hindu deities in filthy language and has been conducting anti-social activities in the church; even though the Petitioner requested the Respondent No.2 many times not to behave in highhanded way the Respondent No.2 paid deaf ear to those words. He further alleged in the affidavit that he and his family could not sleep well because of the high volume loud sounds used in the church, which is adjacent to the house of the Petitioner. Therefore, the Petitioner requested several times to shun the activities of the Respondent No.2, but the Respondent No.2 has not stopped them.

Ms. Pallavi, learned Counsel representing Sri Uday Kumar Vampugadavala, learned Counsel for Respondent No.2 submits that there are specific allegations levelled against Petitioner. Petitioner after granting of an order by this Court on 28.02.2025 dispensing the presence of the Petitioner before the learned Trial Court has not appeared before

the learned Trial Court, at least on one occasion. Therefore, he was causing impediment to the progress of the trial dispute there was no order of stay.

On a perusal of the averments of the complaint submitted by the Petitioner to the police, the allegations are omnibus in nature. Therefore, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.1834 of 2023 on the file of the learned Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Vizianagaram.
