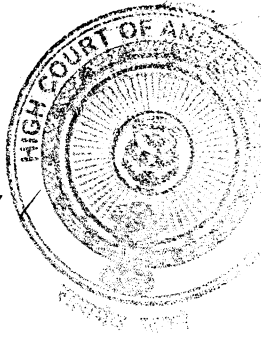

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate Sri L V S Nagaraju presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent in issuing Memo No Estt/77/2020 dated 26-02-2021 in rejecting the claim of the petitioners for regularizing the services and also for payment of the Minimum regular time scale as illegal, arbitrary and Un-constitutional and contrary to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in 2017(1) SCC. 1 in the state of Punjab and others Verses Jagjitsingh and others and consequently set aside the rejection order in Memo No Estt/77/2020 dated 26-02-2021 and direct the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners and also to pay the Minimum regular time scale to the petitioners under the principles of Equal pay, Equal work as per the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in 2017(1) SCC.1 in the state of Punjab and others Verses Jagjitsingh and others with all incidental and consequential benefits duly taking into consideration the length of service put by the petitioners.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri L V S Nagaraju, Advocate for the Petitioners and GP for Cooperation for Respondent Nos.1 & 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.2 & 3 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
