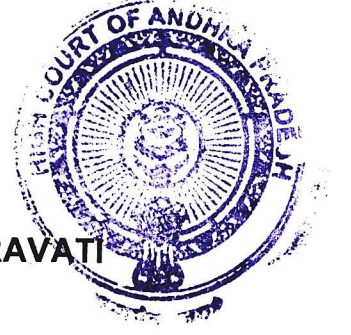

226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction mostly one which is in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring to G.O.Ms.No.29 (ANIMAL HUSBANDRY, DAIRY DEVELOPMENT and FISHERIES DEPARTMENT, AH-III) dated 20-06-2023 is illegal, null and void and against the Articles 14, 21 and 309 of the Constitution of India. Consequently, declare the said G.O is an ultra-virus and colourable exercising the power and set aside the same;
