	19.08.2025	<u>CGR,J</u> <u>I.A.Nos.3, 4 & 5 of 2023</u> These applications are filed seeking to condone the delay of 73 days in filing LR application, to set aside the abatement caused due to the death of sole appellant and to bring LRs of deceased sole appellant on record. None appears for respondents nor any counter affidavit filed opposing these applications. Having regard to the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of these applications, the same are ordered. <u>I.A.No.2 of 2023</u> This application is fled seeking to condone the delay of 369 days in filing the appeal. It is stated in the affidavit filed in support of the said application that initially impugned order has been challenged by way of filing of appeal in C.M.A.SR.No.26083 of 2020 before this Court, however, by order dated	

	13.11.2020 the appellant was relegated to file remedy of filing writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. Accordingly, by withdrawing the appeal, W.P.No.21809 of 2020 came to be preferred. By order dated 24.11.2022 the said writ petition along with other connected writ petitions came to be dismissed as not maintainable and again appellant was directed to prefer appeal under Section 84(2) of A.P. Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987. As such, present appeal has been preferred with aforesaid delay. Counter has been filed opposing the said application. Having considered the reasons stated above and also that in other connected matters already this Court has condoned the delay, as respective parties for pursuing other remedies which ultimately found to be not maintainable and are directed to pursue the appeal, the delay is condoned. Accordingly, the application stands allowed. <u>I.A.No.6 of 2023</u> This Court has already passed interim order dated 21.12.2023 directing parties to maintain status-quo, pending till determination of the appeal.
