5. List this matter along with C.M.A.No.113 of 2026 on 02.04.2026.

6. Till then, the execution of decree for restitution of conjugal rights shall remain stayed but the parties would be at liberty to comply with the decree. ✓

7. On the appearance of respondent, the Court will consider to refer the parties to mediation.” ✓
