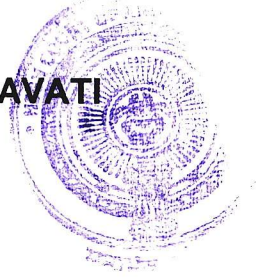

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through its Advocate SRI PRANAY SOHINI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly a writ in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the order dated 22-01-2026 vide Ref No. ZO/VJA/TM and FM12025-26/0038 pertaining to classification of the account of the Petitioner Firm as Fraud as grossly illegal, contrary to law, arbitrary and violative of Article 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently to set aside the same by directing the respondent No.2 to

grant 30 days time to the petitioner to submit all the document pertaining the export of the material and related transactions.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri PRANAY SOHINI Advocate for the Petitioner, Additional Solicitor General of India for respondent no.1, Smt. V.Dyumani, Standing Counsel for respondent no.2, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
