Pavan Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the learned counsel for the petitioner, submitted that he was instructed to appear by the counsel on record and that he is not conversant with the facts of the case. Upon being directed by this Court to argue the matter, the said counsel opened an electronic tablet/mobile phone and admitted that he is not in physical possession of the case bundle. This Court takes serious note of the fact that the learned counsel for the petitioner appeared before this Court unprepared and without the case brief, which amounts to a casual approach to legal proceedings and a failure to assist the Court. This Court is observing a raising tendency among the advocates to appear before the Court without necessary physical papers, relying merely on electronic gadgets and with lack of preparation which is disservice to the Court and to the litigants. In view of the above conduct, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the learned	

		counsel on record for the petitioner to pay costs of Rs. 5,000/- to the A.P.H.C Advocates Clerk's Association. The costs shall be deposited within a period of three (3) weeks from today, and proof of such deposit shall be filed before the Registry. Post after three (3) weeks. <u>JS, J</u> RSD	
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
