The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI Y NARAPA REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, and the Court made the following.

ORDER

"Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent through RPAD and file proof of service in the Registry within a period of four (04) weeks.

3. It is not in dispute that the petitioner is the wife. She sought for transfer of matrimonial lis, citing her physical inconvenience and other reasons.

4. It is well settled law that the convenience of the wife is a primary consideration in transfer cases. This principle has been reiterated in N.C.V.Aishwarya Vs. A.S.Saravana Karthik Sha¹.

5. The matter requires further consideration.

6. Hence, there shall be interim stay of all further proceedings in H.M.O.P.No.204 of 2022 on the file of the learned Senior Civil Judge Court, Kandukur, for a period of eight (08) weeks.

7. List the matter after six (06) weeks.

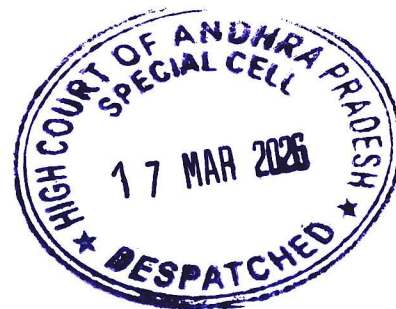
