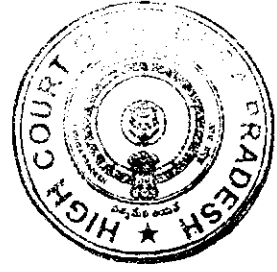

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondents in trying to assign the house site pattas in Sy.No.330 of Bheemasingi Village, Jami Mandal, Vizianagaram District which is classified as Konda Poramboku' pending consideration of application of the petitioner society for renewal of quarry lease as arbitrary, illegal and capricious and violative of APMMC Rules and consequently direct the respondents not to grant house site pattas in Sy.No.330 of Bheemasingi Village, Jami Mandal, Vizianagaram District.
