The Court made the following:

ORDER:

The Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following relief:-

“...to issue an appropriate Writ Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent Nos 2 and 3 is not considering the petitioner representation dated 02 02 2026 and 21 01 2026 not take any action against the named accused in the complaint as being as illegal arbitrary and in violation of Article 21 and 300 A of Constitution of India and consequently praying his Honble Court to direct the respondent nos 2 and 3 to take necessary action against the real culprits in accordance with law and to grant such....”

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader.

3. Sri P.V.Venkata Ravi Sankar, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that respondent Nos.2 and 3 have failed to register an FIR pursuant to the representations dated 02.02.2026 and 21.01.2026 filed by the petitioner against the accused.

4. Sri P. Ajay Babu, learned Assistant Government Pleader, on written instructions, submits that the petitioner submitted a representation dated 07.03.2026 stating that on 22.01.2026 at about 10:30 a.m., the accused A-1 to A-4 criminally trespassed into her land at Survey No.122/03, Naganapalli Village, Ramasamudram Mandal, Annamayya District, abused, assaulted, and threatened her over a land dispute, and she was rescued by villagers and her husband. As no action was taken by the village elders, she lodged a complaint on 07.03.2026, based on which a case in Cr.No.20/2026 was registered under

Sections 329(3), 115(2), 351(2), 351(3), 79 r/w 3(5) of 'the BNS' at Ramasamudram Police Station against the accused persons.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and recording the submissions of the learned Assistant Government Pleader, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing Respondent No.3 to give logical conclusion to the FIR registered against the accused persons in accordance with law.

6. With the above observations and directions, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall stand closed.
