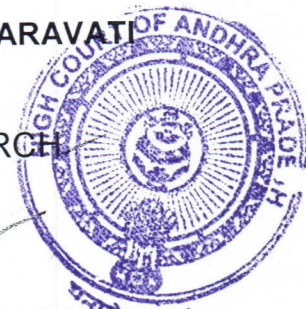

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction, one more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents, more particularly the 3rd Respondent in issuing proceedings No. C1/T2/122(2)/2021 -

RM(T)/DPTO dated 12.02.2025 terminating the license No. T2/122(2)/2021-RM(T) dt.18.02.2021 of the Petitioner which is issued to run the business of Sweets and Bakery stall at OS No.2, as being illegal, arbitrary, in violation of Articles 14, 19(1)(g) and 21 of the Constitution of India and Consequently set aside the proceedings No.C1/T2/122(2)/2021-RM(T)/DPTO dated 12.02.2025 issued by the 3rd Respondent.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the proceedings No.C1/T2/122(2)/2021-RM(T)/DPTO dated 12.02.2025 and permit him to run the shop, Pending disposal of WP 6106 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI AJAY KUMAR KANAPARTHI, Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR TRANSPORT for the Respondent Nos.1 and of Sri A. RAMA RAO, Standing Counsel for the Respondent Nos.2 to 5, the Court made the following

ORDER:

“Sri A.Rama Rao, learned Standing counsel appearing for respondents seeks time to file counter-affidavit.

Sri K.Ajay Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the shop OS.No.2, where the bakery items are stored, has been locked by the 5th respondent. Learned counsel would further requests that the petitioner be allowed to remove/takeaway the items from the shop.

By the proceedings No.C1/T2/122(2)/2021-RM(T)/DPTO(C) dated 12.02.2025 (Ex.P1), license granted in favour of the petitioner was

terminated on the ground of violation of clause Nos.9, 15 and 19 of the license agreement.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the 5th respondent shall allow the petitioner to remove/takeaway the goods or belongings of the petitioner from the shop OS.No.2."
