It is represented by learned counsel for the appellants that based on the decree passed by the Trial Court, the respondent herein filed an execution proceeding in E.P.No.33 of 2026 before the executing Court and the respondent is pressing for disposal of execution petition.

Perused the record.

Considering the averments in the affidavit of the appellant and the facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be an interim stay on all further proceedings in pursuance of decree and judgment, dated 18.12.2025 in O.S.No.54 of 2018 on the file of the IX Additional District & Sessions Judge Court, Krishna District at Machilipatnam, subject to the condition of depositing of suit costs, within a period of eight (8) weeks, failing which, the Interim Stay granted shall stand vacated.
