The averments mentioned in the affidavit filed by the petitioner <i>prima facie</i> shows that in view of the matrimonial disputes, the petitioner/wife has been residing separately along with her child at her parents' house in Chinna Pavani Village, Lingasamudram Mandal, Prakasam District. The petitioner/wife pleaded that she filed a case against the respondent/husband <i>vide</i> H.M.O.P.No.137 of 2025 before the Senior Civil Judge Court at Kandukur, Prakasam District, under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, seeking restitution of conjugal rights and the same is pending for adjudication. The petitioner/wife further pleaded that with a view to cause inconvenience and to harass her, the respondent/husband herein filed a divorce petition <i>vide</i> H.M.O.P.No.76 of 2025 on the file of the Senior Civil Judge, Kovur, S.P.S.R. Nellore District, under Section 13(1)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, seeking for dissolution of the marriage and the same is also pending for adjudication.	

The averments mentioned in the affidavit of the petitioner/wife *prima facie* further go to show that it is very difficult for the petitioner/wife to travel to attend the divorce case proceedings which was filed by the respondent/husband herein before the Court at Kovur on each and every adjournment without any male assistance and as such, the petitioner is constrained to file the present transfer petition.

Perused the record.

Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and for the reasons mentioned in the accompanying affidavit, there shall be an order of Interim Stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioner herein *i.e.* respondent in H.M.O.P.No.76 of 2025 on the file of the Senior Civil Judge Court at Kovur, S.P.S.R. Nellore District, till 10.04.2026.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service in the Registry.
