The Court made the following Order:

The respondent herein, had filed O.S.No.51 of 2024, in the Court of the learned Principal Civil Judge (Senior Division), Tenali, for recovery of money, on the face of a promissory note.

2. The petitioner herein, who is the defendant in the Suit, moved I.A.No.812 of 2025, under Order XI Rule 14 and Section 151 of C.P.C. seeking to summon certain documents from the Karur Vysya Bank and for sending the said documents, along with the disputed promissory note, for comparison, to a Handwriting Expert. The Trial Court dismissed both the applications, by way of an Order, dated 23.01.2026. The first application i.e., I.A.No.810 of 2025, for production of documents, was dismissed, on the ground that, no details had been given. Consequently, I.A.No.812 of 2025, also came to be dismissed.

3. The petitioner had filed C.R.P.No.891 of 2026, in relation to I.A.No.810 of 2025 and the present Civil Revision Petition has filed, in relation to I.A.No.812 of 2025. This Court, by an Order, dated 24.04.2026, had dismissed C.R.P.No.891 of 2026, leaving it open to the petitioner to file a fresh application, with particulars.

4. In such circumstances, this Civil Revision Petition is also dismissed, leaving it open to the petitioner to approach the Trial Court with a fresh application, under Section 45. In the event of the petitioner choosing to file

fresh application, for summoning the documents, the details of such documents be given.

5. Accordingly, this Civil Revision Petition is dismissed with liberty. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
