No. 341 of 2024 on the file of Additional Junior Civil Judge, Repalle, Bapatla District for the alleged offenses under Section 341, 323, 506 r/w 34 IPC.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri YARRAMSETTY VENKATESH Advocate for the Petitioners, and of PUBLIC PROSECUTOR, for the Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted, on or before 21.04.2025, to which date the case stands posted for hearing.

IA NO: 2 OF 2025

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings against Petitioners/Accused No.1 and 2 in CC. No. 341 of 2024 on the file of Additional Junior Civil Judge, Repalle, Bapatla District for the alleged offenses under Section 341, 323, 506 r/w 34 IPC, pending disposal of CRLP No. 2791 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

- 1. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners.**

1. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were arraigned as A.1 and A.2 in C.C. No.341 of 2024 on the file of the Additional Junior Civil Judge, Repalle, for the alleged offence under Sections 341, 323, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
2. The learned counsel further submits that it is alleged in the complaint that the 2nd respondent was obstructed by the petitioners and was abused and physically assaulted. It is submitted that the alleged incident, even as per the complaint, took place on 23.05.2025; however, the complaint was lodged on 28.05.2024. There is an abnormal delay in filing the complaint. It is further submitted that the 2nd petitioner was not in town when the alleged incident took place. He was studying B.tech. It is also submitted that the petitioners and the 2nd respondent are the relatives. On account of some family misunderstandings between them, the 2nd respondent filed the complaint.
3. Considering the submissions, there shall be stay of appearance of the petitioners/A.1 and A.2 in C.C. No.341 of 2024 on the file of the Additional Junior Civil Judge, Repalle, for a period of six weeks.
4. Issue notice to the 2nd respondent.
5. The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to the 2nd respondent and file proof of service.
6. List this matter on 21.04.2025.

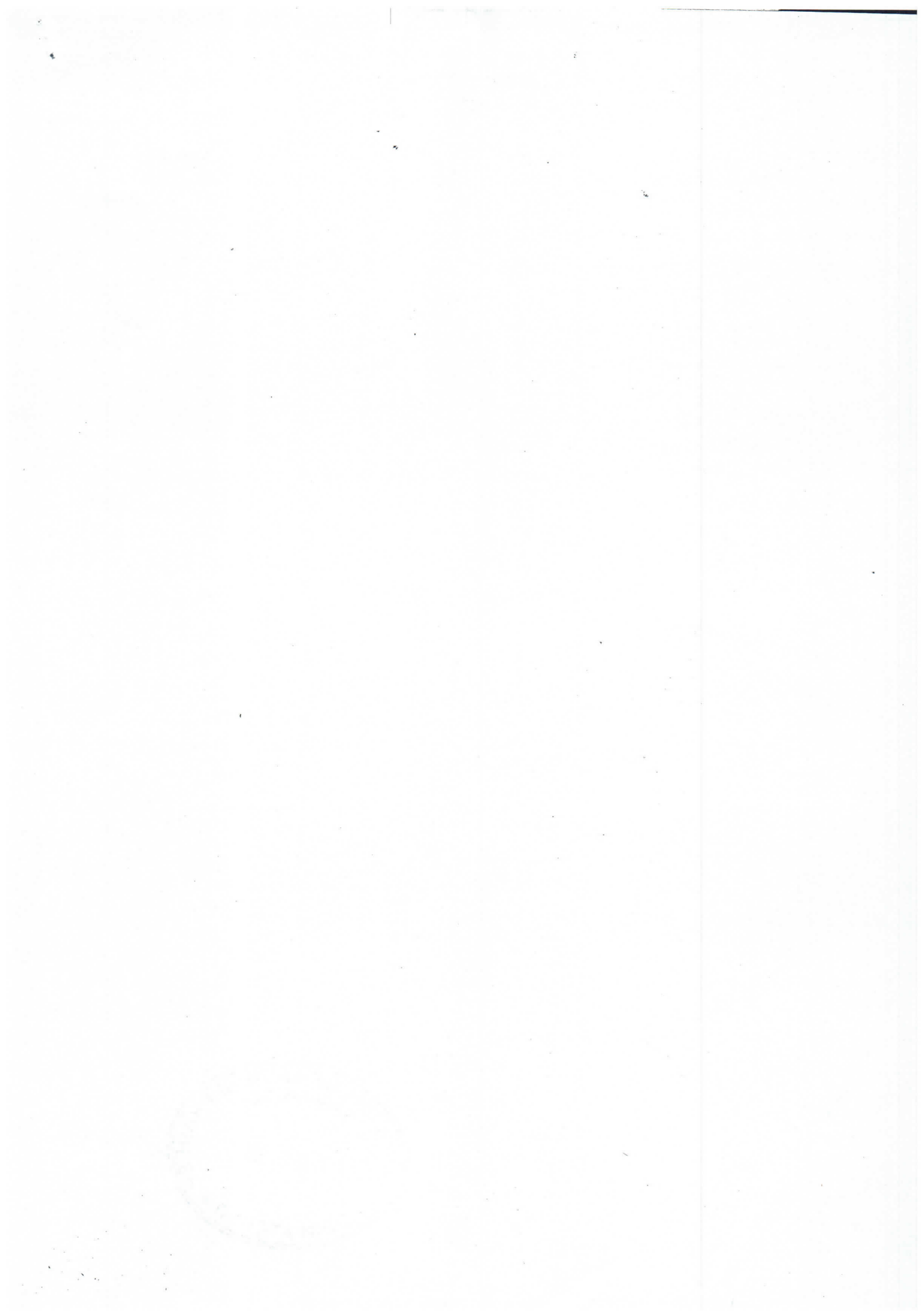
