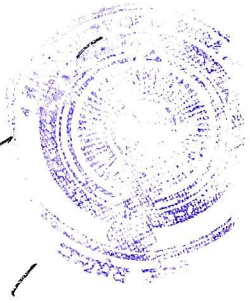

ORDER:

Interim Order, granted earlier, is extended until the next date of hearing.

Matter is referred to mediation. Sri M. Satyanarayana, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

The Station House Officer concerned/the learned Trial Court shall drive the parties to the mediation.

Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediation on 06.05.2026.

The learned mediator shall submit his report within one week thereafter.
