The Court made the following:

COMMON ORDER:

These three Criminal Petitions are heard and disposed of by way of this common order as they arise out of same set of facts and circumstances.

2. Criminal Petition No.1350 of 2025 is filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for brevity 'the BNSS') by the Petitioners/Accused Nos.2 to 4, seeking to quash the proceedings against them in C.C.No.988/2024 on the file of the learned I Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Visakhapatnam.

3. Criminal Petition No.1185 of 2026 is filed under Section 528 of 'the BNSS' by the Petitioners/Respondent Nos.2, 3 & 4, seeking to quash the proceedings against them in D.V.C.No.151 of 2025 on the file of the learned IV Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Court, Visakhapatnam.

4. Criminal Petition No.2823 of 2025 is filed under Section 528 of 'the BNSS' by the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 to 5, seeking to quash the proceedings against them in C.C.No.2282/2024 on the file of the learned IV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada.

5. The Petitioner-husband, Harsh, along with his father, and the Respondent-wife, Naga Navya, along with her father, are personally present in Court.

6. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the parties have amicably resolved their matrimonial disputes *inter se*. A Memorandum of Understanding dated 09.04.2026 has been executed between the husband and wife,

incorporating certain terms and conditions arrived at pursuant to a compromise effected between the parties at the instance of the learned Counsel appearing on behalf of both sides and with the assistance of their respective family members. The said Memorandum of Understanding shall form part of the record of these proceedings, and the Registry is directed to furnish certified copies thereof to the parties upon requisition.

7. One of the material terms stipulated in the said Memorandum of Understanding is that the Petitioner-husband shall pay a sum of Rs.50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Lakhs only) to the Respondent-wife as and by way of permanent alimony in full and final settlement of all claims. In part performance of the aforesaid obligation, the husband has, on this day, remitted a sum of Rs.25,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty-Five Lakhs only) to the wife by way of online electronic transfer. The Respondent-wife submits before this Court that she has duly received the said amount and expresses no grievance in that behalf. A compromise memo, duly signed by both parties, has been filed before this Court.

8. A Compromise Memo has been filed before this Court, duly executed and signed by both the husband and wife. The Registry is further directed to register the Interlocutory Application filed for the purpose of recording the compromise arrived at between the parties in terms of the enclosed Memorandum of Understanding dated 09.04.2026.

9. The Respondent-wife submits that she has no objection to the quashment of the proceedings in C.C.No.988/2024 pending on the file of the

learned I Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Visakhapatnam, in view of the settlement arrived at between the parties. The Petitioner-husband likewise submits that he has no objection to the quashment of the proceedings in C.C.No.2282/2024 pending on the file of the learned IV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada. Both parties are also *ad idem* in expressing no objection to the quashment of the proceedings in D.V.C.No.151 of 2025 pending on the file of the learned IV Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Court, Visakhapatnam, consequent upon the compromise so effected.

10. In view of the compromise arrived at between the Petitioner-husband and the Respondent-wife, this Court is of the considered opinion that the continuation of the aforesaid criminal proceedings would serve no useful purpose and that the ends of justice would be best met by quashing the same. Accordingly, the three Criminal Petitions are allowed, and the proceedings in C.C.No.988/2024 on the file of the learned I Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Visakhapatnam; the proceedings in D.V.C.No.151 of 2025 on the file of the learned IV Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Court, Visakhapatnam; and the proceedings in C.C.No.2282/2024 on the file of the learned IV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada, are hereby quashed in their entirety. Consequently, the proceedings against Accused No.1 in C.C.No.988/2024 on the file of the learned I Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Visakhapatnam, are also quashed.

11. The husband and wife have further unequivocally undertaken before this Court that the Respondent-wife shall withdraw the petition filed by her in F.C.O.P.No.336/2023 pending on the file of the learned IV Additional District Judge, Vijayawada, wherein she had sought maintenance under Section 125 of 'the Cr.P.C.' The husband has instituted a petition seeking dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce in F.C.O.P.No.409/2025 pending on the file of the learned XIV Additional District Judge-cum-Additional Family Court, Vijayawada, and the wife undertakes to extend her fullest cooperation to the Petitioner-husband in obtaining a decree of divorce by mutual consent in the said proceedings. Furthermore, the Respondent-wife, who had preferred a Transfer Petition in Tr.C.M.P.No.246/2025 before this Court, undertakes to withdraw the same on the next date of hearing in the said matter.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
