Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of a writ of mandamus, declaring the action of the 3rd respondent

in issuing the endorsement under special register number 388/2023 dt.24/12/2023, intimating that my lands an extent of 43.60 covered by survey number 162/1, 162/2, 163/2 and 164 B of Pingili Village, Rapur Mandal, Nellore District as forest poramboke lands without any basis and without conducting any survey by putting us on notice and by doing such survey in our presence and without showing any revenue records to state that these are forest lands in spite of the fact that long time back the petitioner been given the Pattadar passbooks and title deeds as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and against the constitutional guarantees and to consequently direct the respondent to intimate the 3 rd respondents Sub registrar to the effect that these lands are not forest poramboke lands and that registration of any conveyance deeds pertaining to these lands could be entertained, registered and released by him and to pass

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Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased issue an interim direction against the respondent to entertain any conveyance deeds pertaining to the petitioner lands, an extent of 43.60 acres covered by survey numbers 162/1, 162/2, 163/2 and 164/B of Pangili village of Rapur, Mandal, Nellore District, to register such deeds and to release the same during the pendency of this Writ Petition.
