Learned Government Pleader seeks time to obtain instructions.

Prima facie, the partition deed dated 20.05.2019, demonstrates that the property sought to be attached was, in fact, the property of the petitioner's grandmother, which devolved upon him and other family members through his mother. In such circumstances, there is an arguable case for the petitioner that the said property could not have been attached for recovery of the tax dues of the petitioner's father.

Accordingly, there shall be stay of all further proceedings pursuant to the notice dated 18.02.2026.
