ORDER:

The present Writ Petition is filed, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking the following relief:

“to issue any writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus or an appropriate writ or order declaring the action of the respondents is not legal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural Justice and to 1.direct the respondents to release the gratuity amount, leave encashment due and surrender Leave bill of 30 days in the Month of November, 2024 due to the petitioner along with appropriate interest within a time frame to be fixed by this Hon'ble Court 2. Advocate Counsel Charges 3.and any other order or orders....”

2. Heard V.V.S.C.Muralidhar Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Services-I appearing for respondents.

3. During the course of hearing, learned Government Pleader for Services-I appearing on behalf of the respondents has placed written instructions of the District Educational Officer, SPSR Nellore District dated 20.4.2026. According to the said instructions all the benefits i.e. encashment of earned leave, surrender leave, gratuity amount are sanctioned and submitted to the Accountant General and the same were also annexed along with the instructions.

4. On perusal of the same, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing respondent no.4 to consider the said proposal and pass appropriate orders within two (02) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.

As a sequel thereto, interlocutory applications pending, if any, in the writ petition, shall also stand closed.
