1.	10.04.2026	<u>CMR,J</u> <u>C.R.P.No.795 of 2026</u> Sri G.Yaswanth, learned Advocate, who is on caveat, takes notice for respondents and requests time to produce certain documents. List the matter on 08.05.2026. <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> The revision petitioner is the plaintiff in O.S.No.47 of 2025 on the file of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Bantumilli. A suit is filed for permanent injunction on the basis of a registered sale deed executed in its favour which contains a recital that the possession of the property was delivered to the petitioner. The trial Court granted temporary injunction. The same was reversed by the appellate Court in C.M.A.No.10 of 2025 on the file of learned IX Additional District and Sessions Judge, Krishna at Machilipatnam on the ground that a suit for cancellation of the sale deed was pending. But the finding relating to the possession recorded by the trial Court is not reversed or disturbed in the order of the appellate Court. Therefore, in the said facts and circumstances	

		of the case, there shall be an order of injunction restraining the respondents from interfering with the possession and enjoyment of the plaintiff, till the next date of hearing. The petitioner shall not make any construction in the plaint schedule property, except enjoying the RCC building which is now existing in the said property. <u>CMR, J</u> ARR	
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
