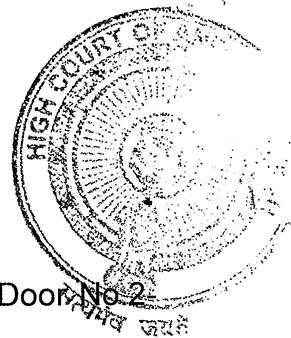

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondent No 1 in issuing the Impugned notice in Rc A 421/2015 dt 12-10-2020 under Sec 7 of the A.P Escheats and Bona Vacantia Act and the consequential Notice in Form-II dt 23-01-2021 under Sec 11(1) of the A.P Escheats and Bona Vacantia Act as arbitrary, illegal, contrary to the provisions of A P Escheats and Bona Vacantia Act and beyond Jurisdiction and Consequently Set Aside the Impugned notice in Rc A. 421/2015 dt 12-10-2020 under Sec 7 of the A P Escheats and Bona Vacantia Act and the consequential Notice in Form-II dt 23-01-2021 under Sec 11(1) of the A P Escheats and Bona Vacantia Act issued by the respondent No 1 in the interest of justice

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the Impugned notice in RC A 421/2015, dt 12-10-2020 under sec 7 of the A P Escheats and Bona Vacantia Act and the consequential Notice Form-II dt 23-01-2021 under Sec 11 (1) of the A.P escheats and Bona Vacantia Act issued by the respondent No.1, pending disposal of WP 7650 of 2021, on the file of the High Court.
