The learned Trial Court straightaway proceeded with the evidence of the accused. The impugned order reflects the same. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in S.T.C. No.106 of 2022 on the file of the learned Principal Civil Judge (Junior Division)-cum-Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tenali, until the next date of hearing.
