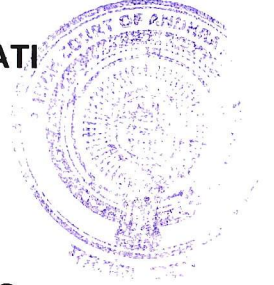

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri PETA GNANA TEJA, presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to set-a-side the order dated 22-01-2026, passed in CrI.M.P.No.2429/2025 in STC No.106 of 2022 on the file of PrI.Civil Judge (Junior Divison)-cum-Judicial Magistrate of I Class, Tenali and allow to recall for cross examination;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri PETA GNANA TEJA, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings in STC.No.106 of 2022 on the file of Pri.Civil Judge (Junior Divison)-cum-Judicial Magistrate of I Class, Tenali, pending disposal of CRLP No. 2064 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is also permitted to take out personal notice to the learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 before the learned Trial Court and file proof to that effect.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that P.W.1 was examined in chief by way of affidavit, but P.W.1 was not cross-examined. The learned Trial Court straightaway proceeded with the evidence of the accused. The impugned order reflects the same.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in S.T.C. No.106 of 2022 on the file of the learned Principal Civil Judge (Junior Division)-cum-Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tenali, until the next date of hearing.
