The Court made the following Order:

The respondent herein, had filed O.S.No.51 of 2024, in the Court of the learned Principal Civil Judge (Senior Division), Tenali, for recovery of money, on the face of a promissory note.

2. The petitioner herein, who is the defendant in the Suit, moved I.A.No.810 of 2025, under Order XI Rule 14 and Section 151 of C.P.C. to direct the Branch Manager, Karur Vysya Bank, for cause production of documents containing the signatures of the defendant which are kept with the bank. This application came to be dismissed, on 23.01.2026, on the ground that, the petitioner had not specified any details or all the documents to be produced.

3. Aggrieved by the said order, the petitioner has approached this Court, by way of the Civil Revision Petition.

4. This Court does not find any reason that the said order in as much as no details of the documents or specifics of the documents, which are summoned, are set out.

5. In those circumstances, this Civil Revision Petition is dismissed, leaving it open to the petitioner to approach the Court with specific details.

6. Needless to say, it would be open to the respondent to take all such defences, in relation to any fresh application that may be filed by the petitioner.
