Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order, direction, more particularly one in the nature of a writ of mandamus, declaring the action of Respondent No.5 and 6 in not permitting the petitioner to discharge his duties in the post of Clerk and further directing the petitioner to not to enter into the office of Vakadu Primary Agriculture Co-operative Society as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, and in violation of the principles of natural justice as well as Articles 14,19(1)(g), and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently, direct respondent no.5 and 6 to not to interfere with the duties of the petitioner who is working in the post of clerk at Vakadu Primary Agriculture Co-operative Society situated at Vakadu village, vakadu mandal, S.P.S Nellore district and pass such

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Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct respondent no.6 to permit the petitioner to continue in discharging his duties as a clerk at Vakadu Primary Agriculture Co-operative Society situated at Vakadu village, vakadu mandal, S.P.S Nellore district pending disposal of the above writ petition and pass such

The Court made the following:

ORDER:

The writ petition is filed seeking to declare the action of the respondents 5 and 6 in not permitting the petitioner to discharge his duties in the post of Clerk and further directing the petitioner not to enter into the office of the 5th respondent-Vakadu Primary Agriculture Co-operative Society as illegal and arbitrary.

2. According to the averments made in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, it is the case of the petitioner that he was appointed as Clerk by the 5th respondent Society on 01.07.2019 with a primary duty to recover loans from the customers. The petitioner has continued the duty till the end of January, 2026. But, suddenly without passing any order or without showing any reasons, the respondents have directed the petitioner not to attend the office from 01.02.2026 stating that his services are no longer required by the society. Accordingly, the respondents have discontinued the petitioner which is contrary and against law.

3. After notice, the respondents have filed their counter stating that they never asked the petitioner not to attend the office. Infact the petitioner he himself discontinued and absented from duties from 01.02.2026 onwards. In view of the absence of the petitioner to duties, respondents did not issue any notice and not passed any orders.

4. Considering the rival submissions and on perusal of the record without going into merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents 5 and 6 to allow the petitioner to attend the duties from 30.04.2026 and to continue him to attend the duties. If the respondents 5 and 6 want to take any action against the petitioner, the same may be done in terms of the procedure contemplated under law after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. No order as cots.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
