Petition under Section 151 CPC., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant interim stay of all further proceedings in HMOP No.6/2026 on the file of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sattenapalli, pending disposal of the above Tr.CMP.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the

following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The averments mentioned in the affidavit filed by the petitioner *prima facie* shows that in view of the matrimonial disputes, the petitioner/wife has been residing separately along with her child at her parents' house in Kothapeta, Gannavaram Mandal, Krishna District.

The petitioner/wife pleaded that in view of the harassment caused by the respondent/husband, she lodged a complaint against the respondent/husband and his family members, dated 05.01.2026, which was registered as F.I.R.No.02 of 2026, for the offences punishable under Section 85 of B.N.S. Act, 2023 and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, before the Mahila Police Station, Machilipatnam, the same is pending for investigation.

The petitioner/wife further pleaded that with a view to cause inconvenience and to harass her, the respondent/husband herein filed a petition *vide* H.M.O.P.No.06 of 2026, before the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sattenapalli, under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, seeking restitution of conjugal rights and the same is pending for adjudication.

The averments mentioned in the affidavit of the petitioner/wife *prima facie* further go to show that the distance between Kothapeta & Sattenapalli is more than 100Kms and it is very difficult for the petitioner/wife to travel to attend the case proceedings which was filed by the respondent/husband herein before the Court at Sattenapalli on each and every adjournment without any male assistance and as such, the petitioner is constrained to file the present transfer petition.

Perused the record.

Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and for the reasons mentioned in the accompanying affidavit, there shall be an order of Interim Stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioner herein i.e. respondent in H.M.O.P.No.06 of 2026, on the file of the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sattenapalli, till 20.04.2026.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service in the Registry.
