Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ of mandamus declaring that the show cause notice No. 439/MDL/SKLM/2017-18 Dt 15-04-2020 as illegal arbitrary, vague and without jurisdiction and violative of principles of natural justice r/w Article 19 and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently set-aside the same.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and affidavit filed in support thereof and order of High Court dt. 30-04-2020 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri N Vijay, Advocate for the Petitioner, and the G.P. for Mines & Geology for the Respondents, the Court made the following

"Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for Mines and Geology.

The matter requires consideration after filing of counter affidavit by the concerned respondents, in view of the contentions raised with regard to the jurisdiction of the third respondent to issue the impugned notice and also the method adopted for calculating seignorage fee alleged to have been evaded.

In such view of the matter, the interim orders granted on the earlier occasion are extended by six (6) weeks.
