W.P.No.32344 of 2025 is filed questioning the Proceedings issued by Respondent No.2 <i>vide</i> Proc.No.979/C-1/2025, dated 13.11.2025 imposing the penalty of Rs.4,000/- and suspending the license of the Petitioner among other directions for violating the permission granted to her for doing aquaculture in the tank admeasuring Ac.2.00 cents situated in R.S.No.137-1D2A, 137-1C of Kommara Village, Ganapavaram Mandal, West Godavari District and the said proceedings was challenged before this Court and this Court on 20.11.2025 had passed an interim order of <i>status quo</i>.</p> <p>2. W.P.No.7713 of 2026 is filed questioning the action of Respondent Nos.2 to 5 in not taking appropriate action on the complaint dated 07.03.2026 submitted by the Petitioner seeking to stop the illegal harvesting of shrimp culture, prevent the discharge of saline aquaculture into the agriculture canal and cancel the license granted to Respondent No.6, and declare the same as illegal and arbitrary.</p>	

		<p>3. In the Counter-Affidavit filed by the un-official Respondent No.5 in W.P.No.32344 of 2025 it is stated that a show-cause notice was issued to the Petitioner prior to the impugned order dated 13.11.2025, wherein the Petitioner in explanation thereto admitted to shrimp culture in the land-in-question and had sought time to close shrimp culture. It is further mentioned in the Counter-Affidavit that as on date neither the aquaculture nor the shrimp culture are being continued in the land-in-question.</p> <p>4. The grievance of the Petitioner in W.P.No.7713 of 2026 is that on account of prawn culture in the land-in-question, their neighbouring lands are now uncultivable on account of pollution and lack of drainage facilities for the land of aquaculture or shrimp culture.</p> <p>5. Heard the counsels.</p> <p>6. The Petitioner in W.P.No.32344 of 2025 herself admitted to shrimp culture in the explanation given to the show-cause notice dated 23.08.2025. In the light of the same, the impugned proceedings dated 13.11.2025 suspending the license of the Petitioner <i>prima facie</i> cannot be faulted.</p>

Therefore, the interim order of <i>status quo</i> is modified as under;</p> <p>i) The Petitioner in W.P.No.32344 of 2025/Respondent No.6 in W.P.No.7713 of 2026 is restrained from doing the aquaculture or the shrimp culture in the land-in-question, pending further orders.</p> <p>8.
