Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court

may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondents in not releasing the admitted bill amount of Rs. 13,15,250/- in connection with Agreement No.91/2023-24 dated 28.02.2024 as illegal, arbitrary, and unconstitutional, and consequently direct the Respondents to pay the said amount along with interest at 18 percent per annum, and pass

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Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents to release the admitted amount of Rs.13,15,250/- pending disposal of the above writ petition and pass

The Court made the following:

ORDER:

Aggrieved by the non-payment of bill amount to the petitioner for the work executed by him pertaining to Construction and Presurvey of High Level Bridge across Uppu Kaluva at KM 7/2-4 of Venkatachalam-Mutukur Road, SPSR Nellore District, *vide* Agreement No.D.R.No.91/2023-24, the present writ petition is filed.

2. Heard Sri Petluri Naga Raju, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Shaik Abdul Rasheed, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Roads & Buildings for the respondents.

3. Sri Shaik Abdul Rasheed, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Roads & Buildings on written instructions dated 20.07.2026 submitted that, the authorities have admitted to pay the entitled net amount to the petitioner and sought three months time for such payment.

4. To the said submission, learned counsel for the petitioner reported no objection, however, prayed to grant reasonable time as the amount is paltry.

5. Taking the submissions of both the learned counsel into consideration and as the authorities are ready to pay the admitted amount to the petitioner, this Court is inclined to dispose of the writ petition, at the admission stage by passing the following order:

“The respondents are directed to release the legally admitted/entitled net amount to the petitioner at the earliest, and at any

rate, within a period of three (03) months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.”

6. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is ***disposed of***. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
