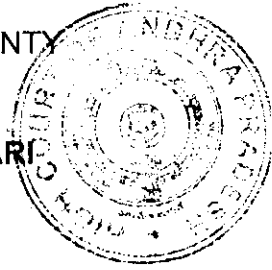

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, direction(s), order, more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS, calling for the records pertaining to the impugned proceedings in Rc.F/1/12109/90, dated:04.08.2009 issued by the 3rd respondent herein and consequential action of the respondent No. 3 to 5 in notifying the land an extent of ac.1.00cents in RS.No. 251 (new no. 389) of Vadhanthapuram village accounts under section 22-A (1) (b) of Registration Act and the proceedings in Roc. REV-FSEC/66-2017-JAF(F8) REV COL CTR DT 27-06-2017 issued by the 2nd respondent as illegal, arbitrary, malafide, without jurisdiction and Power, contrary to the provisions of A.P. Estate Abolition Act, 1948 and violation of Principles of natural justice by setting aside the same and consequently direct the Respondents a) to delete the land an extent of Ac. 1.00 cents of agricultural land in Sy. No 251/3 new Sy No.389 of Vendhantapuram village, Tirupathi Rural Mandal is concerned from the prohibitory category lands us 22 A(1)(b) of the Registration Act, b) to mulate the Petitioner's name in all the concerned revenue records as patta holder in respect of the land an extent of Ac. 1.00 cents in Sy. No. 251/3 new Sy. No 389 of vendanthapuram village, Tirupathi Rural Mandal is concerned c) to issue Pattadar Pass Book and title deed for the said land to the Petitioner duly updating the said land on his name in the web-land in the interest of Justice.

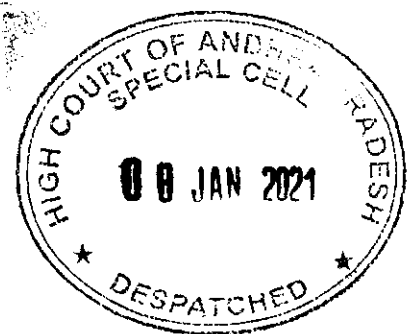
