WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri K.Jyothi Prasad, presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, (Under Section 482 of Cr.P.C)., praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash all further proceedings in CC.No.1221 of 2025 on the file of I Additional Junior Civil Judge cum XI Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Anakapalli, as against them, in the interest of justice;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri K.Jyothi Prasad, Advocate for the Petitioners, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

be and hereby are directed to show cause, either appearing in person or through Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted on or before 20.04.2026, on which date the case stands posted for hearing.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant interim stay of all further proceedings in CC.No.1221 of 2025 on the file of I Additional Junior Civil Judge cum XI Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Anakapalli, in so far as the petitioners are concerned including their appearance, in the interest of justice, pending disposal of CRLP No. 2200 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that there are seven cheque bounce cases pending between the petitioners and

the de- facto complainant. Petitioner No.1 has lodged a complaint against respondent No.2 for the offence punishable under Section 376 of 'the IPC'. There is also another cheating case pending between the petitioners and respondent No.2.

The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that the petitioners have taken Rs.10 lakhs from respondent No.2 under the guise of providing employment in the Telangana High Court, but failed to do so. Subsequently, the petitioner issued certain cheques which were dishonoured. Seven cheque bounce cases are pending between petitioner No.1 and respondent No.2.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the multiple litigations pending between the petitioners and respondent No.2 for one reason or another, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.1221 of 2025 on the file of the learned I Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-XI Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Anakapalli, including the appearance of the petitioners, until the next date of hearing.

Since the offences are compoundable in nature, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms. Rayudu Sudha, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 15.04.2026 and cooperate with the mediation proceedings for an amicable settlement of the issue.

Post on 20.04.2026 for Mediator's report."
