Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings, in FCOP No. 200/2024 on the file of the Family Court cum IV Additional District and Sessions Judge, Kurnool, Pending disposal of TRCMP No. 95 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The court, while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the

following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The averments mentioned in the affidavit filed by the petitioner *prima facie* shows that in view of the matrimonial disputes, the petitioner/wife has been residing separately at her parents' house in Vijayawada.

The petitioner/wife pleaded that she filed three (03) cases against the respondent /husband herein viz., C.C.No.3328 of 2024 on the file of the IV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada, Maintenance Case *vide* F.C.O.P. (MC).No.398 of 2024 on the file of the Principal Family Court Judge at Vijayawada, under Section 125 of Cr.P.C. seeking maintenance from the respondent and Domestic Violence Case *vide* D.V.C.No.174 of 2024 on the file of the I Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada, all the aforesaid cases are pending for adjudication.

The petitioner/wife further pleaded that with a view to cause inconvenience and to harass her, the respondent/husband herein filed a petition *vide* F.C.O.P.No.200 of 2024, on the file of the Family Court-cum IV Additional District & Sessions Judge, Kurnool, under Section 32 of the Divorce Act, 1869, r/w Section 7(4) of the Family Courts, Act, 1984, seeking restitution of conjugal rights and the same is also pending for adjudication.

The averments mentioned in the affidavit of the petitioner/wife *prima facie* further go to show that the distance between Vijayawada & Kurnool is more than 400Kms and it is very difficult for the petitioner/wife to travel to attend the case proceedings which was filed by the respondent/husband herein before the Court at Kurnool on each and every

adjournment without any male assistance and as such, the petitioner is constrained to file the present transfer petition.

Perused the record.

Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and for the reasons mentioned in the accompanying affidavit, there shall be an order of Interim Stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioner herein i.e. respondent in F.C.O.P.No.200 of 2024, on the file of the Family Court-cum-IV Additional District & Sessions Judge, Kurnool, till 29.04.2026.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service in the Registry.
