The Court made the following:

The above writ petition was filed to declare the action of the official respondents in initiating action against the 5th respondent, in running liquor business at D.No.1-134 in Sy.No.177/1 of Peddagonehal Gram Panchayat, and constructing a shed without obtaining permission from the Gram Panchayat, as illegal and arbitrary.

This Court ordered notice on 30.03.2026 and permitted the learned counsel for the petitioner to take out personal notice to 5th respondent.

Sri Kasa Jaganmohan Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner, would submit that the notice was served on the 5th respondent on 07.04.2026 and that proof of service is being filed today.

Ms. Kavitha, learned counsel representing Sri M.Sudhir, learned Standing counsel for the 3rd respondent, submitted a notice *vide* R.C.No.5/2026 dated 13.04.2026, issued by the Panchayat Development Officer of the 3rd respondent to the 5th respondent giving seven days time to the 5th respondent to submit explanation.
