ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner. ✓

The averments in the affidavit filed by the petitioner prima facie shows that the petitioner is none other than the wife of the respondent/husband, due to the matrimonial disputes between both the parties, the petitioner/wife is residing separately at Rajampet along with her male child aged about three years. ✓

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the respondent/husband filed D.O.P.No.429 of 2024, on the file of learned Principal District Judge, Chittoor, under Sections 32 and 33 of the Divorce Act, 1869, seeking restitution of conjugal rights and the same is pending for adjudication. ✓

Learned counsel for the petitioner would further contend that the petitioner/wife has been residing separately at Rajampet along with her male child aged about three years and the distance between Rajampet and Chittoor is approximately 150 kms and it is very difficult for the petitioner/wife to attend the case proceedings in D.O.P.No.429 of 2024, on the file of learned Principal District Judge, Chittoor, on each and every adjournment without any male assistance and that she is constrained to file the present transfer petition. ✓

Perused the record. ✓

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and for the reasons mentioned in the accompanying affidavit, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings including the appearance of the petitioner i.e., the respondent in D.O.P.No.429 of 2024, on the file of learned Principal District Judge, Chittoor, till 29.04.2026. ✓

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to takeout personal notice to the respondent through Registered Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service before the Registry.”
