Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, direction(s), order or orders more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus calling for the records pertaining to the impugned proceedings in Rc.F/1/12109/90, dated: 04.08.2009 issued by the 3rd respondent herein and consequential action of the respondent Nos. 3 to 5 in notifying the land an extent of Ac. 1.00 cents in R.S.No. 251 (new Number 389) of Vedanthapuram village accounts under section 22-A 1 (b) of Registration Act and the proceedings in Roc.REV-FSEC/66/2017-JA (F8) REV COL CTR DT. 27.06.2017 issued by the 2nd respondent as illegal, arbitrary, malafide, without jurisdiction and power, contrary to the provisions of A.P.Estate Abolition Act, 1948 and violation of principles of natural justice by setting aside the same and consequentially direct the respondents a) to delete the land an extent of Ac. 1.00 cents of agricultural land in Sy. No. 251/3 new Sy. NO. 389 of Vedanthapuram village, Tirupati Rural Mandal is concerned from the prohibitory category lands U/S 22 A(1) (b) of the Registration Act, (b) to mutate the Petitioner's name in all the concerned revenue records as patta holder in respect of the land an extent of Ac. 3.20 cents in Sy. No. 251/3 new Sy. No. 389 of Vedanthapuram village, Tirupati Rural Mandal is concerned c) to issue Pattadar Pass Book and tittle deed for the said land to the Petitioner duly updating the said land on her name in the web-land in the interest of justice;

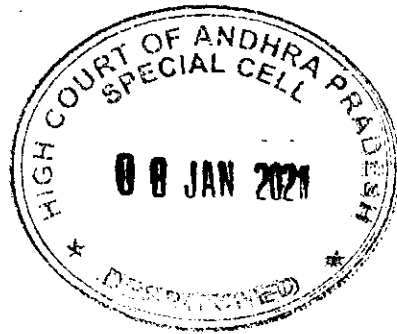
