WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI PATHI SIVA PRASAD presented this Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed herein, the High Court may be pleased to allow the Civil Revision Petition by setting aside the docket order, dated 29.01.2026 in IA. No. 76 of 2026 in OS. No. 8 of 2026 passed by the Hon'ble Senior Civil Judge, Proddatur, Kadapa District

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri PATHI SIVA PRASAD Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this CIVIL REVISION PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith(copy enclosed) this **CIVIL REVISION PETITION** should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant injunction order against the 1st respondent by directing the respondent No. 2 to not to release the retirement benefits to the 1st respondent, pending disposal of CRP No. 1174 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following order:

“The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed against the order dated 29.01.2026 passed in I.A.No.76 of 2026 in O.S.No.8 of 2026 passed by the learned Senior Civil, Proddatur, Kadapa District, whereby the Court below, while issuing notice to respondent/defendant, directed the

Garnishee to withhold the earned leave salary of defendant which may accrue to defendant on his retirement on payment of process by 20.02.2026.

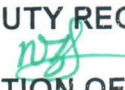
Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner is wife of 1st respondent, who is working as Deputy Para Medical Officer, DM & HO Office, Mancherla Town and District, Telangana and drawing net salary of Rs.1,40,249/- per month. He further submits that 1st respondent is going to retire from service on 31.05.2026 and he is getting retirement benefits exceeding Rs.1,20,00,000/-; that the petitioner filed the petition claiming an amount of Rs.36,00,000/- as permanent alimony, and if only earned leave salary of 1st respondent is attached, it would come about Rs.5,00,000/- to Rs.8,00,000/- only, and if the retirement benefits are disbursed to 1st respondent, it would be difficult for the petitioner to realize the fruits of the decree that is going to be passed in her favour.

In view of aforesaid reasons, this Court directs 2nd respondent herein to withhold an amount of Rs.36,00,000/- permissible under laws from the retirement benefits of 1st respondent. Notice before admission.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondents by Speed Post/RPAD and shall file proof of service in the Registry within a period of Two (02) weeks.
