ORDER:

The present Writ Petition is filed, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking the following relief:

“to issue any writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus or an appropriate writ or order declaring the action of the 1st respondent in not reviewing the suspension, even after issuance of Articles of Charge vide G.O.Rt.No.113 Housing (VIG.CELL.AI) Department dated 04.12.2025 and despite directions of this Hon'ble Court in W.P.No.29982 of 2025 dated 27.11.2025 as being illegal, arbitrary, and consequentially direct the 1st respondent to re-instate the petitioner into service as District Head Housing, Tirupati District, A.P. State Housing Corporation Limited, with immediate effect and to pass....”

2. Heard Meka Rahul Chowdary, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Services-I appearing for respondents.
3. The Writ Petition is filed against all the respondents in not reviewing suspension of the petitioner even after issuance of Articles of Charge vide G.O.Rt.No.113 dated 04.12.2025 despite the directions of this Court in W.P.No.29982 of 2025 dated 27.11.2025.
4. After granting time, learned standing counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents has placed instructions of the General Manager (A&V)/CVO dated 27.4.2026 and according to the said instructions, Government has reviewed the case of suspension of the petitioner vide G.O.Rt.No.26 dated 19.4.2026 and continued the suspension.

5. In view of the above instructions, nothing survives in the Writ Petition.

6. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is closed. No costs.

As a sequel thereto, interlocutory applications pending, if any, in the writ petition, shall also stand closed.
