WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri BHASKAR PREM KOUSHIK, presented this Petition under Section 115 of CPC, having been aggrieved by the Judgment Debtor and the Respondent is the Decree Holder in the above E.P. The appeal is filed against the impugned order dated 19-01-2026 on file of the Principal Senior Civil Judge (PSCJ), Guntur allowing the Execution Petition and directing issuance of ARREST Warrant under Order 21 Rule 38 CPC;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri BHASKAR PREM KOUSHIK, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent herein to show cause as to why this CIVIL REVISION PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant interim stay on all further proceedings against the impugned order dated 19-01-2026 passed in E.P.No.105/2022 in O.S.No.802/2013 by the learned Principal Civil Judge (Senior Division), Guntur; Dismiss the said Execution Petition, pending disposal of CRP No. 1261 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following ORDER:

"Notice before admission.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent by RPAD and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Post on 10.07.2026.

In the meanwhile, there shall be stay of operation of the Order of the Executing Court, dated 19.01.2026, in E.P.No.105 of 2022, subject to the condition of the petitioner depositing Rs.50,000/-, in the account of the said execution petition. The said payment to be made within four (04) weeks from today. Upon such payment, it would be open to the respondents to withdraw the same without any security."
